# The role of the session coordinator

### Session coordinator

The role of the session coordinator is -

- To be present onsite for the duration of the club session. Should the situation arise where this is not possible then the session coordinator will appoint a deputy session coordinator to take over responsibility for running the club session;
- To ensure that all of the club's "Covid-19 Return to Play Rules" are being adhered to by all players throughout the session. The session coordinator must report any breaches of the rules to the committee;
- To ensure that all players have registered their attendance for the club session;
- To direct players, once they have signed in, to an allocated court so that players are not congregating on or around the court before play;
- Responsible for announcing that play has stopped on court, and for ensuring that all players stand on the court service line before directing them to their next position on the courts with social distancing being maintained;
- To have sole responsibility for adjusting the height of the net on court if required;
- To sign-off the club session register at the end of the club session.
